# **Teaching Posts**

## A) Post Graduate teacher (PGT)

## **Educational and other qualifications**

#### **Essential:**

(i) Master's Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/ Institution's norms) in the following subject:

- (ii) B.Ed or equivalent degree from a recognized University. However, if no candidate with B.Ed is available, then candidates without B.Ed may be taken provided she/ he has passed the qualifying degree with first class (60% marks or the equivalent grade).
- (iii) Proficiency in teaching in English medium.

Note: Candidates having Special B.Ed are not eligible for the post of PGT.

## B) Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT) (BIO/CHEM & HINDI/SANSKRIT) Educational and other qualifications Essential:

i) Three years Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University / institution's norms) in the subjects concerned / combination of subjects and as well as in aggregate.

#### OR

Four years integrated degree course of Regional College of Education of NCERT with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University / Institution's norms) in the subjects / combination of subjects concerned and as well as in aggregate.

The elective subjects / languages in the combination of subjects are as under

- (ii) The candidate should possess the professional qualification of B.Ed. However, Candidates who have passed CTET will be preferred..
- (iii) The candidates with professional qualification of **Special B.Ed. or D.Ed. or Special D.Ed.** are not eligible to apply for the TGT posts.
- (iv) Proficiency in teaching in English medium (except for TGT (Hindi/ Sanskrit)).

<u>METHOD OF SELECTION</u>: Candidates will be selected on the basis of a written test, followed by a skill test. Only the candidates securing minimum 50% marks (general category) and 45% marks (reserved category) in the written test, will be eligible for the skill test.
